Bruce County and Huron County are the only two Counties out of ten that have increased over the past four years. The rest of the Counties have decreased pig production.

Bruce has increased 37% since 1998 and Huron has increased 24.5% since 1998

Overall western Ontario has remained stable in pig production 1,845,200 in 1998 to 1,884,950 in 2001 an increase of about 3%

Therefore 20% of the counties in Western Ontario have taken 51% of the pig increase in population, whereas 80% of the Counties have reduced their pig population approximately by the same number of pigs.
